WHAT WE ARE LEARNING

Phonics



In phonics this term, we will continue to build on our knowledge of digraphs, helping children to recognise and use a wider range of letter combinations in their reading and writing. We will focus on developing greater fluency when reading, encouraging children to read with increasing confidence and accuracy. Alongside this, we will work on making more precise spelling choices, supporting pupils in selecting the correct sounds and patterns when writing independently.

Drawing Club

We will be diving into a range of fiction stories, using our imagination to create exciting possibilities. We will also look at how rhyme is used in stories and within poetry.

MATHS



In maths this term, we will build confidence with number, explore patterns, and develop early problem-solving skills through practical activities. We will look at numbers up to 20, explore 2D and 3D shapes, and share and group objects into equal amounts.

Enhanced Provision

Lots of our learning will be themed on exploring the world around us, with a focus on plants and growing. Children will learn how things change over time.
